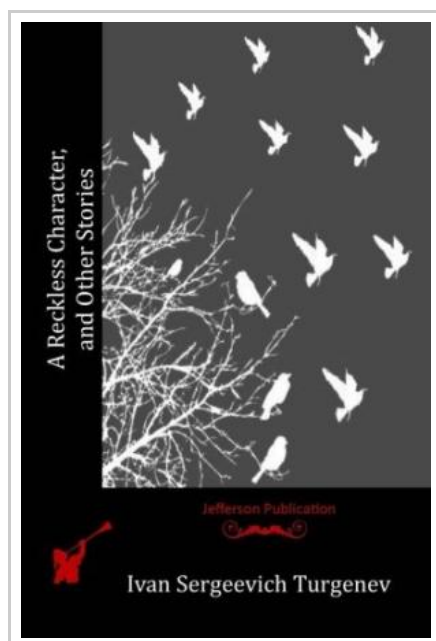




A Reckless Character, and Other Stories
